Assembly Bill No. 339, now known as Chapter 1588 of the Government Code, by Honorable Ralph M. Brown, Democrat, Member of the Assembly, 30th Assembly District, of Modesto, adds Chapter 9 to Part 1, Division 2, Title 5, Government Code, regarding meetings of the legislative body of any local agency to be open and public, with certain exceptions, and provides other regulations under which such meetings shall be held.

I have received several inquiries regarding this change in the previous law. In general, the new law prohibits a school board, a city council, or other legislative body, from holding a closed meeting in advance of the public meeting and deciding in the closed meeting how the members will vote on certain issues during the open, public meeting.

Several people have said that they know of cases where local legislative bodies have held secret, closed meetings in advance of the public meetings, and they (my correspondents) want to know what they can do about it. My advice is to discuss this with the legal advisor of the local legislative body, such as the city attorney in the case of a city council holding a secret, closed meeting, and then going to the District Attorney of Los Angeles County if the legal advisor of the local legislative body does not provide a satisfactory solution. In other words, I believe in giving local authorities and local officials an opportunity to explain their ideas before going higher.

School Employees
Assembly Bill 39, now known as Chapter 88, Education Code, amends Section 13521 and Section 13883, Education Code, regarding cause for dismissal of school district certificated employees. It makes advocacy or membership in an organization advocating overthrow of Federal or State Government by violence, force, or other unlawful means cause for dismissal of a permanent employee of a school district or of a probationary employee of a district having an average daily attendance of 60,000 or more pupils. It also makes advocacy or teaching of Communism, by a teacher in the public schools, with intent to indoctrinate a pupil with, or inculcate a preference in the mind of any pupil for, Communism a cause for dismissal of such probationary employee, as well as such permanent employee.

column ask me for legal advice. I am not a lawyer. It is unlawful for me to give legal advice. However, I can report what the Legislature had in mind when the law was passed. When inquiries are very involved, I send them to the Legislative Counsel in Sacramento. In theory, he is just one person, but in reality there are thirty or forty lawyers in the

office of the Legislative Counsel who write bills to be introduced by Members of the Legislature and also answer our inquiries. This is a valuable and important function of the State Government.

What Comes First?
After a talk that I recently gave at the Inglewood High School, a High School student asked me: "What should come first, a person's loyalty to his political party or his loyalty to the United States? My answer

is that loyalty to the United States comes first. We should read and understand the United States Constitution and other great fundamental documents of freedom, and at all times and in all places uphold and defend the Constitution against all enemies, foreign and domestic. Secondly, we should understand and uphold the Constitution of the State wherein we live. If we do not like provisions in the United States and State constitutions, there are orderly pro-
