

Hunt-Killers Get Wrists Slapped

At least 23 careless hunters, according to Director Seth Gordon, who killed or wounded other don of the Department of Fish and Game during the last five and a half months now face the lifetime loss of their hunting licenses, such thing as a hunting "accident," Gordon stated that the department was entering wholeheartedly into the spirit of the new legislative law requiring his agency to report every hunter or livestock shooting case to the local district attorney for prosecution. More than 50 hunters have been killed or wounded since the law went into effect on September 9, 1953.
