TORRANCE HERALD RESOLUTION NO. 2498

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO VACATE THE TRACTS CONTAINING WALKWAY IN TRACTS 12 AND 13 OF BLOCK 2, AND TRACT 1202 AS RECORDED IN MAP BOOK 383, PAGES 33 AND 34, ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY RECORDER, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA; AND THAT TEN FOOT DEDICATED WALKWAY AS SHOWN BETWEEN LOTS 12 AND 13 OF BLOCK 2, ALL IN TRACT 14579 AS RECORDED IN MAP BOOK 383, PAGES 33 AND 34, ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY RECORDER, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA; AND THAT TEN FOOT DEDICATED WALKWAY AS SHOWN BETWEEN LOTS 12 AND 13 OF TRACT 16982 AS RECORDED IN MAP BOOK 383, PAGE 35, ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY RECORDER, COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

WHEREAS, such vacation will cause no hardship of any kind to adjacent property owners; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of the City of Torrance has recommended approval of said petition to vacate said Walkway; and the said City Council herewith declares its intention to vacate said Walkway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Walkway to be vacated and the details of said vacation are more particularly shown upon a map bearing the title "Map showing proposed vacation of a certain Walkway in Tracts 1202, 14579 and 16982 in the City of Torrance," which map is hereby approved for the purpose of filing in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Torrance and ordered filed February 3, 1954, and which map is hereby referred to for particulars as to the proposed vacation.

RESOLVED that the 9th day of March, 1954, at 8:00 o'clock p.m. of said day in the Council Chamber of the City Hall of the City of Torrance is the time and place fixed when the City Council will meet for the adoption of this Resolution; that at said time any objections that may be made to the vacation of said Walkway shall be heard and passed on; and in the event all objections are heard and are overruled, the City Council shall be deemed to have jurisdiction to order said Walkway heretofore described to be vacated.

RESOLVED that this resolution be published once a week for at least three successive weeks prior to the day fixed herein for the meeting of the said City Council in a newspaper of general circulation and in the Torrance Herald, published in the City of Torrance, and that this Resolution be conclusively posted upon the premises of the Walkway heretofore described to be vacated, not less than three hundred feet apart, and not less than three in number.

RESOLVED that in the herein proposed vacation of said Walkway as aforementioned, the Council of the City of Torrance hereby elects to proceed under and in pursuance of the provisions of the State of California (Chapter 184 of the Statutes of 1941) as amended.


