# District Jaycees Plan Dinner Meeting Tonight

Jaycees of District 12 will meet tonight in the Alan-Richard Hall here to meet the candidates for state offices and to choose a state vice-president to represent them in the State Jaycee organization.

Hosts for the meeting of Jaycees from El Segundo, the beach cities, Torrance, San Pedro, and Wilmington will be the Torrance club, according to local President Vern Lovelady.

Visiting Vote seekers will include seven aspirants for national directorships, Lovelady said, and several candidates for state and district offices. Senate President Ira Kaye of San Pedro is expected also.

Three candidates who are in the race to succeed Kaye are the top Jaycee in California will be on hand. They are Phil McClure of San Francisco, Phil Knox of Oakland, and Andy Cordova of Downey.

About 200 Jaycees are expected to attend the dinner meeting and enjoy the barbecued prime rib dinner, according to Dave Figueredo and W. C. Weaver, Torrance Jaycees who are heading up the dinner arrangements committee.

Election of the state vice-president may be the hottest issue on tonight's agenda. Seeking the office are Royce Dyer of Wilmington and Bill Walker of El Segundo, both well known for their Jaycee activities in the district.

Another highlight of the evening will be the district Jaycee Speakoff, with the Torrance Club represented by Past President Marvin Goettsch.
