

Three first selected for flawless quality, it then goes to the grinder where it advances through four stages of surfacing and finishing. From there it goes through four gradations of emery polishing, from coarse to superfine.

The lens is then checked and rechecked for microscopic accuracy with a lensometer. After the accuracy of the lens is ascertained it is cut to shape, ground to specified size, and fitted into the frame. The actual fitting of the glasses to the individual contours of a person's face is the last segment of the process.

### Door-to-Door Church Drive Opens Friday

A door-to-door visitation by thousands of Episcopal workers next Friday will kick-off the 10-day Episcopal Advancement Fund campaign for \$1,180,000 for missions, Christian Education and welfare work in the Eight-county Diocese of Los Angeles. During the 10 days' united drive, every Episcopalian in Southern California will be visited. Parish workers, supplied with lists of church people, will canvass designated areas and report to local parish chairmen.

Final result of the campaign will be announced in all churches Sunday, June 21.

At 7:35 p.m. next Friday thousands of Episcopallians in Southern California will be tuned in to KTTV to hear the Rt. Rev. Francis Eric Eloy, Bishop of Los Angeles, give the key address that will start the diocesan undertaking. Chester Rude, Los Angeles banker, general campaign chairman, will also speak on the kick-off broadcast. Music will be provided by the adult choir of St. James', Los Angeles, under the direction of Robert W. Schmidt, organist-choirmaster.

The 11 a.m. service in each of the 159 parishes and missions of the diocese, Sunday June 14, will be a Service of Dedication for the undertaking, and all churchmen active in the campaign will make their corporate communion at that time.


