

### Moose Win Merit Certificate in National Contest

Torrance Lodge No. 785, Loyal Order of Moose, today was awarded a framed certificate of merit, signifying honorable mention in the annual national Moose Civic Affairs Awards competition.

The local lodge, competing in classification "C"—lodges with less than 500 membership—conducted an outstanding 19-point program of civic affairs that highlighted service to the youth of Torrance.

Robert F. Hineleigh, noted radio and television news commentator, chairman of the Moose Civic Affairs judging committee, made the presentation to local lodge representatives at the 68th annual international convention of the Moose, Miami, Fla.

More than 1700 Moose lodges in the United States and Canada annually compete in this contest. A total of more than 200 different civic affairs projects, ranging from Christmas parties for underprivileged children, the maintaining of playgrounds, sponsoring Boy and Girl Scout troops, to operating blood banks, donations of life-saving equipment and supervising drives for disaster funds, were engaged in by the member lodges, the contest disclosed.

George C. Powell, a past governor of the lodge, was chairman of the local Moose civic affairs committee, and he was awarded a framed citation by the national committee. Gold plaques, or first place awards, were presented to Spokane, Wash., Class "A"—lodges with 2000 or more members, Redding, Calif., Class "B"—lodges with from 500 to 2000 members, and San Fernando Valley, Calif., Class "C". Silver plaques, second place awards, went to Eugene, Ore., Class "A," Mason, Ga.; Class "B" and Barrie, Ont., Canada, Class "C." Third place bronze plaques were awarded to the following: Columbus, O., Class "A"; Lewiston, Ida., and Clarkston, Wash., Class "B"; and Bartow, Fla., Class "C."

### Far Right Right Is Highway Rule For Heavy Stuff

"Only the far right will be all right!"

One of the 133 vehicle code changes to become effective on Sept. 9 cites the truth of this statement to a considerable segment of California's vehicle population. Commissioner B. R. Caldwell of the California Highway Patrol announced today.

"Beginning Sept. 9, any vehicle which is normally required to be driven at a reduced maximum rate of speed because of weight, will also be required to operate in the right hand lane of traffic or as close as practicable to the right edge or curb," Caldwell explains.

Vehicles affected by this amendment include any motor truck and trailer, any motor truck alone or truck tractor with a semitrailer when the gross weight is 25,000 pounds or more, and any vehicle with solid rubber or metal tires.

Only exceptions to this provision will be to allow these vehicles to leave the right hand lane when passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction or when preparing to make a left turn.

"For several years there has been a law requiring all traffic moving slower than the normal flow to keep to the right," the Commissioner comments, "but this new section identifies certain types of vehicles which must always operate in the right hand lane after Sept. 9. "Enforcement penalties will be adjusted accordingly," he adds.

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
