**Training School For Retarded Children Slated**

The Harbor Area Exceptional Children's Foundation will sponsor a cooperative training school for mentally retarded children at the Toberman Settlement, 131 N. Grand, San Pedro, beginning Sept. 21 at 9 a.m. It was announced this week by Mrs. C. E. Bowen, press chairman.

Those who have not already registered may do so Sept. 21 from 9 a.m. to 12 noon at the Settlement. Mrs. Bowen reported. A volunteer staff will be available to offer information regarding transportation and finances.

The school will be partially financed by the parents of the attending pupils. Its purpose and aim will be to train the children toward social adjustment in the home and school, endeavoring to develop the individual child to his fullest possibilities, Mrs. Bowen revealed.

According to the California Highway Patrol this National Safety Council slogan for September summarizes the best possible advice for motorists. "Youngsters intent on a football, a foot race or a playful dog, never seem to have time to watch for traffic hazards. Their personal problems seem too important to them.


"Now that classes have resumed, motorists must accept added responsibility for the protection of children," advises E. R. Caldwell, commissioner of the Patrol.

"Parents are urged to review and reemphasize pedestrian and bicycle safety rules so that youngsters will know their own part of the job," he adds.

Last year 4500 children under 15 years of age were killed in traffic accidents, with the greatest increase recorded during the last four months of the year and during the afternoon and early evening hours.

"While we appreciate that children sometimes disregard danger signals, every motorist must remember that one moment of forgetfulness can re-

sult in a fatal collision. ers must beware," Caldwell re- "Since children may dare, driv- iterated.




