The City Council of the City of Torrance does hereby resolve as follows: WHEREAS, the City Council has been petitioned to vacate a portion of the City of Torrance, more particularly described as follows, to-wit: That portion of Lot 8 of Torrance Tract as recorded in Map Book 23, Pages 84 and 85, on file in the County Recorder's Office...
