Residents of southwest Torrance who have requested the city take "early action" to develop a park on a five-acre site near the Seaside Elementary School will soon be advised of a meeting at which the matter will be discussed.

Roy McCann, representing homeowners in the area made the plea for the recreational area at the last meeting of the City Council. Councilman Willy G. Blount recommended that the homeowner groups in the area meet with the council, the planning commission, and the recreation commission to discuss the matter.

McCann pointed to an enrollment of 852 students at the Seaside School as proof of need for such a park. He added that additional children were moving into the area each day as many new homes in the vicinity are being completed and occupied.

No date has been set for the meeting but a city hall spokesman said the homeowners would be notified when the meeting has been scheduled.


