ARMISTICE DAY

Thirty-five years ago today France was sagging at the knees. Germany's soldiers were within a hop skip and jump from Paris with a war weary, defeated army to stop them. Our soldiers were landing and our Marines were ready but the impression of our Allies was, "Americans are soft, will buckle and run under the first hail of lead."

Our Marines were moved in to delay an invincible army. They were to be expendable. Those boys stood up, fought, wouldn't budge, stopped that invincible horde, drove it back, back, back. With crushing defeat certain the German High Command asked for an Armistice. On November 11, 1918, the electrifying words were flashed, "Cease firing." That war was over.

Let us bow our heads for two minutes next Wednesday, Nov. 11th, in humble memory of the boys who did the impossible; fought; stopped, pushed back an invincible army to humiliating defeat.
