Mendez in Return Engagement Monday

First of a series of six joint concerts with the Torrance Area Youth Band and Rafael Mendez, the "World's Greatest Trumpeter," will be given in the Torrance Civic Auditorium on Monday night, Nov. 30th.
The concert will begin at 8:15 p.m. and admission will be \$1.20 per person. Proceeds from this concert as well as the remaining five concerts to be given in other California cities will be used to purchase instruments.
Other concerts are scheduled for Redondo Beach, Dec. 8th; Santa Barbara, March 28th; Compton, May 23rd, and Inglewood and San Bernardino. Dates for the latter two cities are as yet not set.
Monday night's concert in the Civic Auditorium was originally scheduled for San Pedro but had to be changed to Torrance because the Los Angeles Board of Education would not release one of their auditoriums to the youth band.
This will be a return engagement for Mendez. He played here to a full house last spring during the band's anniversary concert. Many people who did not get a chance to see and hear this great artist last spring will have the opportunity to hear him in some of the numbers he has featured on television and records.
Aside from the Mendez numbers, the band will play "A Mighty Fortress Is Our God," Rossini's "La Gazza Ladra" overture, "Legend" by Paul Creston, Eriedman's "Second Slavonic Rhapsody," Morton Gould's "Red Cavalry March" and "Covboy Rhapsody," and Johann Strauss' "Die Fledermaus" waltzes.

Kids will scour their attics and closets for used but usable clothing through the week of Dec. 7 through 11 hunting for clothing to take to school on Bundle Day.



Council Delays Hearing on Chemical Plant

Hearings by the City Council on the operation of the John Wiley Jones Co., packagers of chlorine products, was delayed 30 days on the request of Atty. Walter Anderson, representing the company before the city fathers Tuesday evening.

The Council had taken steps to close down the plant recently when chlorine gas escaped from the operation threatening nearby residents. Several serious plumbing inadequacies were cited in the move, but City Plumbing Inspector Arthur E. Moore reported that these were either corrected or would be in a few days.
The Council was told that the company was negotiating for a nearby site to relocate the operation.
