Predators Routed By State Trappers

Department of Fish and Game trappers took 813 predators on game lands during May, before moving up to higher elevations to protect deer herds during the early summer fawning period.

Included in the catch were 204 coyotes, 196 bobcats, and 443 lesser predators. Two mountain lions were bountied by State hunters, and six others were turned in by private shooters.

Top coyote take of the month was registered by State Trappers Lloyd Brown, who cleaned 44 of the wily predators from deer and quail habitat in the Cucamonga, San Bernardino County, area. Trapper Clarence E. Hagan, headquartered in Monterey County took 39 bobcats.
