World Council To Be Visited By Rev. Taylor

The Rev. John Taylor of the First Methodist Church left this week to visit the World Council of Churches in Evanston, Ill., Aug. 15-29, at which 1660 delegates from all over the world will represent 170,000,000 church-goers.

The Council, held every six years, will not be held again in the United States for 76 years, it is estimated. Each six years, it convenes in a different country. The Rev. Taylor will visit the meeting while on his vacation. The World Council is composed of 161 denominations from 48 countries and was organized six years ago in Holland.

Goal, Theme Told
Goal of the meeting is "unity without unification," and the theme is "Christ—the Hope of the World." The Rev. Gene Gehres, minister at the Community Methodist Church of Waverly, will speak on this theme for the next two Sundays.

The Council has taken the refugee problem to heart since the war and have rescued and resettled more refugees than all other private agencies put together. It has spent \$49,000,000 for relief in the past five years.
