

ly, but you'll have just as good a chance to win as any grownup. The only equipment needed for each player is a square of thin cardboard and a pair of scissors.

At a signal, each player must cut his square into nine pieces, making them as irregular in shape as possible. (Figure 1) When this has been done, another signal must be given at which a player passes his nine pieces to his neighbor at the left. Each player then lays the nine pieces down upon the table and starts fitting them together (Figure 2) to make a perfect square as they were in the beginning. This is hardest to do if the cardboard is the same color on both sides, making it impossible to tell which is the right side of the pieces and which is the wrong.

The one who completes a perfect square first is the winner of the game.

## Square Dance Classes to Start At Civic Auditorium on Sept. 21

The Recreation Department announced this week that it has joined with the Torrance Adult Club to sponsor another series of adult square dance classes in the Torrance Civic Auditorium beginning at 8 p.m. Tuesday, Sept. 21.

Each Tuesday evening for the following 30 weeks there will be classes held at the Civic Auditorium across the street from the Torrance City Hall.

All adults who want to learn to square dance are invited to enroll in this class. Adults may register for the class at the Recreation office, 1247 El Prado, or by phoning FAirfax 8-4108; or they may enroll at the Civic Auditorium any one of the first three or four Tuesday nights of the department. He hopes that the dance classes are scheduled. A minimum charge of 50 cents a person, or \$1 per couple will be made to help defray the expense of the class.


Reese To Call

Adults planning to attend the class scheduled for Tuesdays are asked to enroll as early as possible. If the response is as good as it was last year, it will again be necessary to close enrollment early.
