

Airport Move Planned by Trailer Firm

Mayflower Trailer Co., Harbor City, has completed negotiations for a new six-acre plant site in the newly developed 368-acre industrial tract located adjacent to Torrance Airport, according to V. C. Johnson, president.

Plans are now being drawn, and construction will begin immediately on five buildings to house the general offices and various production units, fabrication and assembly, cabinet shop, paint shop and finishing department.

In releasing news of his company's expansion program, Johnson said the new plant will enable Mayflower to meet back-order commitments to present dealers and allow the establishment of new dealer franchises.

Impossible under limited manufacturing facilities at the out-grown Harbor City factory.

More than \$250,000 will be represented by the first units to be constructed, with completion scheduled for early 1955. The present force of 75 people will be doubled when production begins at the new plant.

During the past year, Mayflower became one of the five largest trailer manufacturers on the Pacific Coast, according to Johnson.
