Smog is Problem Of State -- Hahn

Supervisor Kenneth Hahn this week advocated that air pollution control laws be strengthened by the State Legislature and placed under the administration and supervision of a five-member commission.

The smog situation is our most serious local problem and is rapidly becoming state-wide, if not a national problem," Supervisor Hahn said, adding that the plan would "take local politics out of smog."

He urged creation of a state-wide Air Pollution Control District, on a regional basis, under the supervision of a commission appointed by the Governor.

Control Powers Limited Hahn pointed out that under present laws the County Air Pollution Control District does not have the power to abate smog arising from industries located just outside Los Angeles County.

Everyone is aware, he said, that some smog comes from other counties, and listed as an example the contribution to the air pollution problem in Los Angeles County by the Kaiser Steel Works in Fontana.

Supervisor Hahn stated that there are a number of full time state-wide commissions that administer problems of general state wide concern. These include the State Public Utilities Commission, whose five members receive \$14,000 a year; the Youth and Adult Authorities, both of which have five members each paid \$12,000 a year. Even the City of Los Angeles pays a five member Board of Public Works Commission \$10,000 a year each.

Full-time Board Needed "Air pollution problems are so serious that they would demand the full time of five commissioners working eight hours a day, 40 hours a week, 52 weeks a year," Supervisor Hahn said.

He stated that after a year ago when he appeared before the State Assembly Committee on Public Health, he advocated and urged that a different governmental body be set up for air pollution control.

Yule Fools Are Menace On Highways "Remember, being the life of a party may be the death of you!" With this grim warning, the Los Angeles Chapter of the National Safety Council launched its pre-Christmas safety campaign this week.

The chapter has coined the phrase don't be a "Yule Fool" as they urged motorists who drink not to drive. They suggest that if you have taken on more than your share of Christmas spirits you ride home with someone else or take some kind of public transportation.

"The alcoholic content of your blood at the time you are apprehended determines your case in court—that is, if you haven't made the test useless by spilling too much blood on the highway on the way home," a reminder from the Council reads.

Report Asked On Oil Smog A report that methods used in refining crude petroleum have no bearing on the amount of smog coming from refineries has been referred to the Southern California Air Pollution Foundation for evaluation.

Supervisor Kenneth Hahn asked for the evaluation of the report by Air Pollution Control Director Gordon P. Larson. He had requested a study of the effects of catalytic cracking of petroleum products on air pollution, compared with older methods, such as thermal cracking.


Hahn said he doubted the validity of Larson's findings.
