ORDINANCE NO. 725
AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 442
 The City Council of the City of Torrance does ordain as follows:
SECTION 1:
 That Ordinance No. 442 of the City of Torrance, adopting the Uniform Building Code, 1952 Edition, as approved by the active members at the 27th, 28th and 29th annual business meetings of the Pacific Coast Building Officials Conference, and the same is hereby amended by adding Sections (c) to (f) to Section 1 of said Building Code as follows:
 3505 (c): Footings and Foundation of Walls Subject to Seasonal Volume Changes, Footings and foundation walls when located on adobe or other soil subject to seasonal volume changes, shall be of concrete, poured integrally and continuous under all exterior and interior bearing walls. They shall be reinforced continuous top and bottom, for one-story buildings, two 1/2-inch round steel bars, minimum, two stories and over, two 3/8-inch round steel bars, minimum. All access openings shall be provided below access openings and crawl holes any such crawl hole shall be dropped to provide a reinforced concrete beam section and shall be not closer than ten (10) feet to any intersecting exterior walls. Footings shall be reinforced with reinforcing rods. Foundation walls supporting wood shall extend 4-inches above the finish grade adjacent to the wall at all points. Foundations for all buildings where the surface of the ground slopes more than one (1) foot in ten (10) feet shall be level or shall be stepped so that both top and bottom of such foundation are level.
SECTION 2:
 That Ordinance No. 443, an amended, except as amended herein, shall remain in full force and effect.
SECTION 3:
 This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Torrance, and this Ordinance, therefore, shall take effect and be in full force immediately after the passage and adoption hereof.
 The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be published in the Torrance Herald, a semi-weekly newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Torrance.
