

NTCIA Will Oppose 174th Zoning, Murl Reeves Says

The Planning Commission has been asked to hear the objections of the North Torrance Civic Improvement Assn. to one phase of zoning in that area, Murl Reeves, president, announced yesterday.

The request was in the form of a letter approved by the association's board of directors. Reeves pointed out that the NTCIA is opposed to C2 zoning for 174th St., from Prairie Ave. eastward, on the north side to a point 78 west of Glenburn,

and on the south side to Ainsworth Ave.

Objectionable Things Included

C2 zoning would permit such things as light manufacturing, filling stations, garages, feed and chain stores, dance halls, billiard parlors, and cocktail bars, he said.

Last year, he declared, north Torrance residents strenuously objected to erection of a filling station in the area.

At the same time, he announced that the regular meet-

ing for the NTCIA, set for Wednesday, will be postponed until 9 p.m., in order to allow members to attend the meeting.

Weeks Named

Herman Weeks will replace John Mulvihill as chairman of the NTCIA recreation committee, Reeves also announced. Mulvihill resigned in order to accept appointment on the Planning Commission.

He was actively supported by the north Torrance group for the appointment, and has lived

in Torrance about a year at 3765 W. 171st St. A job analyst for North American Aviation Co. he is a former law student at DePaul University.

Leadership Rewarding, But Trying, Solomon Declares

A good recreation leader has good in his heart and a sense of values, as well as patience, hope, courage, and objectives.

That is what Ben Solomon, editor of "Youth Digest" and noted recreation leader, told heads of a number of local youth groups here last week at a workshop.

A highly skilled person does not necessarily make a good leader, he said. There are certain penalties in being a leader, he pointed out, with a group usually divided for and against the leader.

The leader must prove to the group that he belongs, and must be willing to devote his time to its activities, he declared.

If necessary, the program must be brought to the youth in the form of branch centers, inter-group events, and community recreation, Solomon said.


Professional recreation leaders must rely to a great extent on volunteer laborers, who can do great things, he said.




