**Out-of-Use Articles Can Help Salvation Army Work**

Out-of-use articles in Torrance homes can be put to good use at the Salvation Army Social Services Center that serves this area.

The articles can provide vital occupational therapy for homeless and handicapped men who repair them in the big center's workshops, said J. Hugh Sherfey Jr., chairman of the citizens committee assisting in the annual Salvage Week campaign here.

During the drive, April 18-23, Salvation Army Red Shield trucks will call in response to telephone calls from local residents to collect discards.

Proceeds from sale of the reconditioned articles are used to feed, clothe and house hundreds of men who call upon the Center for help.

Cast-off materials contributed in 1954 enabled the Center to provide 268,550 hours of occupational therapy, 60,180 meals and 20,150 lodgings.

Brigadier William J. Parkins, manager of the Center, said the social rehabilitation program requires a constant inflow of usable articles such as clothing, shoes, furniture, dishes, mattresses, bedding, kitchen utensils, home appliances, silverware, stoves, radios, rags, rugs, books, and bric-a-brac.
