

Steel Company Starts on New Plant Office

Construction of new office facilities for Bethlehem Pacific Coast Steel Corporation's new Fabricating Works in Torrance has just begun.

The new all steel air conditioned office building will feature cellular steel floor sections and movable steel wall partitions. The fluted steel wall panels will be in charcoal gray and white porcelain to blend admirably with the bright red of exposed structural members.

"Design, type of construction, and use of decorative colors were of prime importance so that this new industrial building would be an attractive addition to the community of Torrance as well as Southern California in general," Fuller declared.

Albert C. Martin & Associates are the Architects and Engineers and the Myers Brothers Construction Co. are the General Contractors for this new office building. Both firms are in Los Angeles. The new building which will have over 18,000 sq. ft. of floor space, is scheduled for completion in four months.
