Temporary Vet Housing To Be Razed

In order to provide the thousands of people of the areas with badly needed recreational facilities, the board of supervisors has granted permission to the County Housing Authority to demolish temporary housing units located on county-owned property at Alondra Park, Supervisor Kenneth Hahn announced yesterday.

"These units were built in 1944 strictly as a temporary measure to provide returning veterans with a place to live and to give them a chance to get on their feet," Supervisor Hahn declared.

He pointed out that the buildings were erected on an emergency basis for temporary use only and that they did not comply with safety regulations of the building department and the fire department.
