Al Chandler, Crack Camino Golfer, Sets for U.S. Open

With a record of 21 wins and no defeats with the crack El Camino college golf squad this year, Al Chandler contends that he and his fellow Warrior, Harold Blake, could challenge any two college players in the country.

The pair successfully survived stiff competition in Sacramento, San Francisco, Monterey, and other California cities during the past season. Chandler maintained an average of 72, with a one-stroke handicap.

Chandler will play qualifying rounds today and tomorrow for the National Open. He hopes to gain entry in the tourney's amateur division.

A native of New Orleans, La., Chandler is a graduate of Leuzinger High School. A resident of the South Bay area for seven years, he was the winner of the National Caddies' tournament in 1952.

On the Ohio State University golf course in Columbus, Al was victorious in eight rounds of match play in the caddies' national. As first place winner, he was awarded a \$1500 college scholarship to be used anywhere in the United States. Following his win, he appeared on Ed Sullivan's "Toast of the Town" show in New York.

Meets Ben Hogan

During his caddie encounter, Chandler met and played with his favorite professional golfer, Ben Hogan, who was entered in the celebrities' Tournament on the same course. Other well-known personalities whom he has met on the links include most of the professionals. He was sponsored in the caddie tournament by Bob Hope and Bing Crosby.

More than 20 trophies attest to his prowess on the course. Among his many wins are the Pasadena City championship, in which he shot a 65 for his best score on the links; the Los Angeles City championship; the Long Beach City championship; the Pomona Valley championship; and the Red Hill Amateur championship. He was a member of the three-man Los Angeles Harding cup team which finished second to Dallas, Texas, in the National Public Links tournament.

Starting as a caddie at the age of 11, Chandler developed an interest in golfing.

In general, most of California's deer herds passed the winter in good shape, although there were scattered die-offs, Department of Fish and Game reports show.

On many winter ranges, the herds were forced to feed almost entirely on shrubs, resulting in widespread over-browsing of the better food plants. Unusually cold weather delayed the growth of grass. Fortunately snow conditions were not severe, and deer remained scattered.
