 The City Council of the City of Torrance does ordain as follows:
 THAT public convenience and necessity requires the establishment of certain traffic control installations to be established on certain streets in said City.
 NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE that the following regulatory traffic signs be established on the following streets:
STOP SIGNS:
 (a) At Cabrillo Avenue on alley between Sartori and Grand City Avenue.
 (b) Four-way STOP on the intersection of alleys between Arlington, Engracia and Cravens Avenues.
PARKING:
 (a) Parallel parking on East side of Abalone Avenue between 220th and 223rd Streets.
