Salesman Ends Own Life With Exhaust Fumes

A 28-year-old Torrance salesman, under pressure of mounting debts, ended his own life Tuesday night by inhaling deadly fumes from his auto exhaust.

Detective Capt. Ernest Ashton declared that all circumstances point to suicide.

Thomas Ueshima, 17201 1/2 Yukon Ave., father of a 3-month-

old baby, attached a garden hose to his exhaust pipe, crammed paper into spaces to make it airtight where they joined, climbed into the trunk compartment of his car in the garage, let down the lid, and was overcome.

His body was discovered by his father-in-law, living in the

front residence at 17201 Yukon, at 6:30 a.m. Tuesday.

Ueshima's wife, Kimlye Ueshima, a graduate of Gardena High school, told officers that her husband had left the house at 7:30 p.m. Monday saying that he was going to make a

kitchenware sale in Lakewood. She went out to baby sit for a

neighbor. When she returned at 11 p.m. she found the doors locked, and a note in Japanese.

Capt. Ernest Ashton said Mrs. Ueshima thought the note was a joke, and not being able to read Japanese, stuck it in her pocket, returned to the neighbor's house, and later destroyed the note, she said.
