### Manuscripters Receive Tips From Bradbury

"I have finished a story every week for 17 years," admitted Ray Bradbury, famous short story and screen writer who spoke to more than 100 writers and their guests in Hermosa Beach recently. Professional and beginning writers from Los Angeles to Long Beach formed the record crowd who heard the author describe the philosophy which has directed him in his craft. This was his fourth annual visit at Southwest Manuscripters. "People are ideas," Bradbury believes. "Each interprets his own religion or union or party on different basic experiences. Therefore, there is only one of you. You are irreplaceable." The developing writer, Bradbury concluded, must write truth as he personally discovers it rather than to imitate. His most recent short story, "The Sound of Summer Running," is scheduled to appear in the Saturday Evening Post within three weeks. Also scheduled for this month is the third small Bradbury. The Bradburys and their two daughters live in Los Angeles. Southwest Manuscripters meet the third Friday of each month at Clark Stadium, Valley Drive, in Hermosa Beach. The public is welcome at any meeting, according to Peter Boesch,
