

### CAP to Hold Open House

### Lad Attempts Suicide, In Crash on Ride to Hospital

A 14-year-old north Torrance youth who attempted to end his own life with a .22-caliber rifle shot, was released from Harbor General Hospital Monday.

Officers investigating the shooting said the boy shot himself in the left side with the rifle in his home Sunday while his parents were away.

Enroute to the hospital, the Wright's ambulance which was carrying him collided with an auto in the intersection of 208th St. and Normandie Ave., but the youngster and other occupants of both vehicles escaped injuries. A second ambulance was dispatched to the scene to continue the trip to the hospital.

Torrance police officers said the boy apparently was despondent following a quarrel with his father. In a note which he

had addressed to his mother, he said: "The devil will get me, but I am bad anyway. Tell my girl friends I like them a lot."

When his 12-year-old sister and a neighbor couple rushed in after hearing the shot, the lad told them, "I'm a bum shot."

### Mayor Asks Judge's Aid

South Bay Municipal Court Judges John A. Shidler and Otto B. Willett were the recipients of Mayor Albert Isen's letters this week from Torrance Mayor Albert Isen, asking for strict enforcement of the dog leash ordinance.

When the City Council voted down a compulsory rabies vaccination law for dogs at their regular meeting last week, the council authorized Mayor Isen to write the letters to "interested authorities" asking their help in enforcing the law. Both proponents and opponents of the controversial vaccination measure agreed the leash law should be more strictly enforced, Isen's letter to the judges said.

Isen's letter also pointed out that punishment for violation of this law has been "ineffective" in the past.


