Aerial Map May Be Used On Sand Pit

Possibility of an aerial survey of the Torrance Sand and Gravel property above Pacific Hills, to determine if it is operating within the boundaries of its variance was suggested to the Council this week by City Manager George Stevens.

The proposal by Stevens was an alternative to the request of the Council recently for a field survey of the property. Stevens said the lowest estimate on such a job was \$675, and that he thought an aerial plotting of the area could be done much cheaper.

The Council requested the check on the survey firm's boundary on the suggestion of Councilman Willys G. Blount, who wanted definite limits established for the operation. The firm is permitted to excavate gravel in the area under a zone variance granted recently by the city.

In the meantime, operators of the gravel pit have announced plans to begin moving the hopper back as required by their recent variance approval.

Project Nearly Done

Construction of sanitary sewers at Milton Street and 204th Streets in the vicinity of Torrance will be completed by November 14, it has been announced by Supervisor Burton W. Chace.

Chace stated the work is costing \$95,013, and is being done under the supervision of County Engineer William J. Fox. The job was started July 25.
