

Money Slated For Missions

Fifteen new foreign missions projects will be aided by the special offering which was taken Saturday morning at the Torrance Seventh-day Adventist Church. Pastor Glenn L. Goffar announced yesterday. The local offering, part of a nation-wide drive for \$100,000 to extend foreign missions in 10 areas of the world, is one of the largest and most important taken in the Adventist Church. Given annually, all funds received go directly to opening new hospitals, schools, and other missions' enterprises, and none is used for existing work, the pastor said. The denomination conducts organized work in 198 of the world's 230 countries.

Check Veteran Insurance

To Assure Right Benefits

"If you are one of the six and a half million veterans who are keeping up their government life insurance," said Mrs. Helen K. Dill, director of the Torrance area Veterans Service Center, you probably know that there's more to being properly insured than just making regular premium payments. "Every veteran insured under an NSLI or USGLI contract has the unrestricted right to designate a beneficiary, to select an optional settlement, to name an alternate (contingent) beneficiary and to change beneficiaries at any time."

**Examples Prepared**  
"Failure to do so has frustrated the intent of many veterans when they were no longer around to set things right. That's why the VA recently prepared 90 examples of beneficiary designations and optional settlements."

Mrs. Dill went on to say that each insured veteran has four options in specifying how the proceeds of an NSLI policy are to be paid out in the event of his death, ranging from payment in one lump sum to monthly installments during the life of the beneficiary.

**Changes Made Easy**  
In addition, the veteran may name one, two or more beneficiaries to receive the proceeds—each under a different option if need be.

Marriages, divorces, births of new children, assumptions of new obligations, deaths in the family circle—all should make the veteran pause to re-evaluate his insurance needs. The VA has made it very easy for him to do so. All he has to do is fill out a new form and mail it to the VA. The new selection takes the place of any earlier ones.
