## THE SHOESTRING STRIP

### 3 Accidents, Hold-Up Creating Excitement in Shoestring Strip

The Strip was the scene of considerable excitement last week.

Last Thursday evening Mrs. Connard Walton (Alice), 21924 S. Denker Ave., received cuts on her face, nose, and right leg when her car collided with one driven by Arvid M. Peterson, 17, 1124 W. 218th St. Her car continued into a tree after the crash, which occurred at 219th and Harvard Sts. She was

taken to Harbor General Hospital.

Her husband now is in Japan, with the Navy, aboard the USS Bremerton. A veteran of four years' service, he left in November and will return in about two months.

On Friday on the corner of Harvard and Carson Sts. another bad accident occurred. It started back at the corner of 228th and Western, where two men held up and robbed a service station attendant, Bill Grondahl, 20, of Los Angeles.

The bandits then took off after beating him with a gun in a car later found to be stolen. They went to Carson with Bill, giving chase in his pickup. They then became involved in the crash at the corner of Harvard and Carson.

The woman injured in this crash was Mrs. Olga Sinatra, 43, Buena Park, who received a fractured skull and internal

injuries. The bandits then went into the yard of Mrs. Mazola Lewis, 1308 W. 218th St. Then struck her in the eye and pulled her from her car. The pair drove away in her car.

Grondahl and Mrs. Lewis were treated for cuts described as "not serious."

The neighborhood was very shocked to hear of the death of Donna Mae Bose, 16, of 1528 W. 218th St., last Thursday. Donna had many friends here and in Lomita where she attended school.

She is survived by her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Donald Bose, and a brother, Fred, and grandfather, J. G. Bose. Services were by Stone and Myers Chapel last Monday.

Roy and Vicky are living at 1620 Greenwood Ave., Torrance. She is formerly of Boulder City, Nev.




