

## Narbonne Senior Receives North American Study Aid

pany's Scholarship Committee chairman. Johnson will graduate in June from Narbonne High School, Lomita. He plans to study engineering at UCLA. His father is a plant guard at North American's Los Angeles Division.

One of 10  
One of 10 winners of the 1957 scholarship competition for children of employees, Johnson will receive up to \$650 a year for tuition and fees and an expense allowance of \$400 per year.

Inaugurated in 1956, North American's College Scholarship Program this year attracted 115 candidates enrolled in high schools throughout the nation. A preliminary test produced 33 semi-finalists who took the College Board Scholastic Aptitude Test in January.

Took Tests  
Final selections by the company's Scholarship Committee were based on comparative test results, detailed scholastic and other information obtained from the candidates' high schools, and other available indications of capability, achievement, and college and career potential.

Winners may select any accredited college or university, but must enroll in an approved engineering, related science, or business administration course. Scholarships are good for the normal four or five years of undergraduate work provided the student continues to qualify under terms of the program.

Johnson is a member of the math and physics club at Narbonne High and has been active in other school affairs.

## Second Phase of Cancer Crusade Launched Here

Following successful completion of the three-hour Cancer Memorial crusade, volunteer workers for the American Cancer Society in Torrance launched the second phase of their month-long educational and fund-raising campaign.

Their plan: To reach every commercial and industrial firm and its employees with life-saving facts about cancer and to accept contributions for the continuation of the Society's year-round program of research, education and service.

"Industry has a vital stake in the battle against cancer," Al Hinz, Commerce and Industry Chairman in South Bay Area reported.

"While it's difficult to put a dollars-and-cents value on human suffering, yet the record shows that each year new cases of cancer diagnosed amount to about 12,000,000 patient-days lost in hospitals, and about 3,000,000 man-years of work. Dollarwise, the annual loss is about 12 billion dollars," Hinz said.

"It's not just a management problem, nor just a labor problem," he said. "It's hurting us all and I'm sure we can expect fine support from both management and labor in our current attempts to put cancer on the run."

Information about the various positions and application forms may be obtained at the main Post Office in Torrance.


