

### 3 Missionaries Lead Rally at Lomita Church

Several "World Mission rallies" are being held at the Lomita Missionary Church from Feb. 29 to March 4 with services nightly Wednesday through Sunday except Saturday.

Missionary speakers are Rev. Charles Glenn, missionary to Ecuador; Rev. Eugene Ponchot, missionary to Sierra Leone, Africa; and Miss Virginia Meter who is doing missionary work in Hawaii.

The rallies will outline the work of the 84 missionaries in 16 lands who represent the Missionary Church Area.

Rev. Glenn will present the work of pioneer missions. He and his wife went to Ecuador in 1948 and spent several years in missionary work with the Cayapa Indians.

They were the first missionaries in the area. Rev. Glenn will show color pictures of their work.

Rev. Eugene Ponchot will outline the work of the Missionary Church Area in Sierra Leone. He is one of 23 missionaries in that field.

In Africa he assisted in the field hospital, aided in building, did elementary teaching of nationals, evangelized in the villages, and did some translation

work. He will return to Africa in May.

Miss Virginia Meter spent one term of four years in missionary work in Hawaii. She will tell of the work of the association in Hawaii.

Miss Meter with five others has been ministering in three cities on the Island of Kauai. She was active in conducting and directing gospel services in Sunday School and Bible Club work, in directing musical groups, and in home visitation. She will show color pictures of Hawaii.




