





## Three Civil Air Patrol Pilots Visit Air Academy

Three local Civil Air Patrol cadets of South Bay Squadron 43 were among the 60 honored cadets from California Wing selected to inspect the USAF Air Academy at Lowery AFB, Denver, Colo., during Easter vacation.

Cadet 2nd Lt. John Ranzazzo and Sgt. Martin Hoxworth of San Pedro, and Sgt. Leroy Thompson of Torrance were among the cadet contingent who took off from Long Beach AFB for a two-day visit devised as an incentive award for cadets earning the certificate of proficiency, the "diploma" of the Civil Air Patrol cadet program.

The visit was endorsed by national headquarters of Civil Air Patrol and the Air Academy. Major James D. Hunter, USAF assistant director for the Candidate Advisory Program of the Air Academy, paid a high compliment to Civil Air Patrol in a letter approving the cadet inspection.

"This academy highly endorses the activities of Civil Air Patrol as yours is the organization which has lent more support to the AF Air Academy in its formative stages than any other, be it military or civilian," he wrote.

Ten per cent of the first class of the Air Academy were former Civil Air Patrol cadets. Their record has proven that because of their previous training in the cadet program, they exhibit greater motivation and interest in the future of America's Air Age. This thought was expressed by many high-ranking USAF officers during the recent Pacific Regional Conference held in Long Beach.

The Civil Air Patrol cadet program is open to young men and women, 15 to 18 years of age, who are interested in a thorough grounding in the fundamentals of aviation together with training in military drill and discipline.
