
Hale Named to Bank of America Board

The big green X-ray truck of the Los Angeles County Health Department will move into the Torrance Health District, Tuesday, May 15, to begin a five weeks' stay at 16 locations throughout the area, according to Dr. E. A. Kogan, district health officer.

The schedule includes stops in Gardena, Redondo Beach, Lawndale, Manhattan Beach, Hermosa Beach, Redondo Beach, Waverly, Lomita, and Torrance. The complete schedule is as follows:

Lawndale: May 25, 15386 S. Hawthorne Blvd.
Manhattan Beach: May 28 and 29, Aviation and Manhattan Beach Blvd.; May 31 and June 1, at the City Hall.
Hermosa Beach: June 4, Pier Ave. at Hermosa Ave.
Redondo Beach: June 6 and 7, 701 N. Pacific Coast Hwy.; June 8 and 11, Pacific Ave. and Hermosa; and June 12, 1516 S. Pacific Coast Hwy.


