If you have some extra love you're willing to give to unfortunate youngsters, the Children's Bureau of Los Angeles has an important job for you. The group, now celebrating its 50th year of service, is looking for couples who are willing to open their homes to youngsters either on a full-time or day-care basis.

Locally and throughout the metropolitan area, more than 100 foster couples have joined in suggesting this as perhaps the most satisfying service a husband and wife can render.

Torrance couples helping out include Mr. and Mrs. Clyde H. Goodman, 4509 Highgrove, and Mr. and Mrs. William D. Harlan, 3502 W. 224th St.

The Red Feather placement agency, through its foster homes, cares for children of unwed mothers, children from broken homes whose mothers must work and children whose parents are ill or for other reasons must give them up temporarily.

Mrs. Norman Freestone, president of the bureau, said the additional foster homes are desperately needed for youngsters who are caught in the backwash of living in a busy metropolitan area.

"Foster parents, who are paid for their services, often have the opportunity by giving love and affection to provide a sense of security that will help children the rest of their lives," she said.
