

'A Trip to Mars' Leaves Daily At Griffith Park

Griffith Park Observatory's summer vacation space travel spectacle, "A Trip to Mars," and the 500 seat, air-conditioned planetarium are teaming to offer thrills and cool comfort to Southlanders and tourists.

The Los Angeles City Recreation and Park Department has announced that the simulated rocket ship "trip" to Mars is offered at 3, 6:30, and 9:15 p.m. daily, with extra matinees presented at 4:15 on Saturdays and Sundays.

No Reservations.

Observatory director, Dr. Dinsmore Alter, has stated that the Los Angeles scientific center's traditional "no reservations" policy for planetarium shows will be in effect through the run of "A Trip to Mars."

The Observatory's doors open at 2 p.m. daily throughout the summer, and visitors are invited to browse through the Hall of Science before and after presentations of the imaginary "flight" to Mars.

Zeiss Built.

Made possible by a battery of specially built, high-powered projectors and the intricate Zeiss planetarium machine, "A Trip to Mars" creates a perfect illusion of a jaunt to the planet which in September will be the closest to the earth since 1924.

Through projection magic, Dr. Alter's "passengers" board gigantic space ships and are transported first to an artificial satellite 1000 miles above the earth's surface, and then to the "desert" planet itself.
