Stray Dogs Dangerous, Kogan Warns

With summer vacations at hand and the accompanying influx of visitors and their pets to the beach towns, Dr. E. A. Kogan, district health officer, is urging that parents instruct their children in the care and handling of dogs.

A recent increase in animal bites has resulted in many painful lacerations and disfiguring scars, especially insofar as small children are concerned. The doctor suggests that the following points be stressed in training children to have a healthy respect for a stray dog as well as for the family pet:

low a child to romp over or maul a dog.
 Frequently a dog will chase a child in play. This should be discouraged as certain breeds are hunters and may have a temporary loss of memory and revert to hunting instincts.
 If a dog is behind a fence or in a car, do not attempt to make friends with him.
 If a child or adult is bitten by any dog, the police or the health department should be notified at once.
