

'Sea Around Us' Is Theme For Fishermen's Fete

The "Sea Around Us" has been selected as theme of the 1956 Fishermen's Fete to be held in San Pedro, Sept. 14-16, Dr. Milton C. Spire, general chairman, announced yesterday.

Submitted by John F. Gault, San Pedro High School teacher, the theme idea was taken from the title of a recent best-selling book by Rachel Carson. It will be used as the basis for decorating the fishing boats which will parade through Los Angeles Harbor as the climax to the colorful Fiesta.

Gault, who entered the theme contest for the first time this year, will receive a \$50 savings bond from the San Pedro Chamber of Commerce. His theme was selected from a record number of entries submitted by 183 persons from all over Southern California.

Judges included Mason Case, manager of the Fishermen's Cooperative Assn., chairman; William Sheets, director of the Los Angeles County Art Institute; and Mrs. Alice Tennyson Hawkins, retired San Pedro school teacher and member of the Writers Guild and Art Assn.

Local Plant Gets National Safety Council Award

In recognition of their outstanding safety record compiled during 1955, employees of Pittsburgh Plate Glass Company's Torrance Plant Division have been cited by the National Safety Council to receive its "Certificate of Commendation." H. E. Post, general manager, announced Friday.

The plant official revealed that workers had completed 2,232 accident-free man-hours on the job last year to become eligible for the National award. Post pointed out that since October 24, 1954, local employees have increased the total to 458,974 man-hours without a lost-time disabling injury running through last December.

The National Safety Council offers the Certificate of Commendation to industrial units completing a perfect record of 200,000 to 1,000,000 man-hours. It is provided automatically, if the record covers an entire calendar year, or on application if the record covers two or more calendar years.

Earlier this year Torrance plant employees were also recognized by the company when they received the "Certificate of Honor," Pittsburgh Plate's top safety award offered annually for an accident-free record.


Two assistant directors have been named to the staff of the instruction department at the college, working with Dr. William H. Harless.
