

# Farm Machinery Will Be Shown Again At Fair

Back again after an absence of several seasons, farm and industrial machinery will be a major attraction at the 29th annual Los Angeles County Fair in Pomona, Sept. 14 through Sept. 30. Responding to popular demand, President-Manager C. B. Afferbaugh has set aside some 35,000 square feet in an outdoor pavilion for the purpose, and leading manufacturers and distributors will present their latest implements to an attendance of well over a million visitors.

For several seasons there has been an exhibition of light garden machinery and equipment in connection with the floriculture department. This continues as usual. It is located in the floral building and receives its share of attention especially from new home owners intent upon "do-it-yourself" landscaping.

This year, a record of approximately 275,000 square feet are given over to purely commercial exhibits. Some 60,000 square feet are set aside for a comprehensive automotive show. A house trailer display occupies a large amount of space. Other outdoor living and recreational supplies including boats, hunting and fishing equipment, golf and archery are well represented.

Three large exposition buildings are given over to commercial exhibits largely pertaining to the home, such as appliances, decorations and countless labor saving devices. Builder's supplies and materials have their place in the \$100,000 Home Builders New Products building.

Last fall more than a million visitors viewed these exhibits during the 17 days. This year even more are expected.
