Vets Warned: GI Insurance Plan Changed

Recently discharged veterans, and servicemen due for release before the end of this year, no longer have 120 days after their separation from military duty to apply for a government life insurance policy.

This privilege ends for servicemen will soon be a thing nearly all servicemen and veterans on Dec. 31. At the same time, automatic indemnity—the so-called "free insurance" will also be discontinued.

"Both benefits," explains Mrs. Helen K. Dill, director of the Community Chest sponsored Veterans Service Center, "are being terminated by an act of congress, to be replaced by a new program of aid for the survivors of those who die as a result of military service."

Applications Asked
She urged servicemen and veterans who are interested in government term insurance for their families' protection to apply for it, along with the first installment payment, before the year-end deadline. Applications must be postmarked

not later than the stroke of the new year.
"The only veterans who can obtain government insurance on or after Jan. 1, are those with service-connected disabilities," said Mrs. Dill. "However, they too must apply within one year after the VA finds their disabilities to have been caused by, or aggravated in, military service."

"New Deal" Starts
A "new deal" for the survivors of military service personnel begins in 1957, said Mrs. Dill. Instead of insurance or indemnity or compensation payments, should a serviceman die, they will receive monthly benefits known as "indemnity compensation." The amount of this benefit will depend on the rank of the deceased, and will tie in with his Social Security earnings.


Adult Speech Class Slated
