
Saxons, remember! Sportsmanship is something that we should use all year round. Let's carry that football spirit right into basketball season.

Final casting for the senior play is taking place this week. "Dear Ruth" will be presented by the class of '56 in February.


The campus looks just about the cleanest ever. The seniors and juniors shared in the

"clean-up" class competition this week. They've done a pretty good job of keeping paper in the trash cans. Let's see how the underclassmen do now.


