**Sunday Topic Studies God As Preserver**

"By a prophet the Lord brought Israel out of Egypt, and by a prophet was He preserved" reads the Golden Text from Hosea (12:13) in the Lesson-Sermon "God the Preserver of Man" in all Churches of Christ, Scientist, Sunday.

The prophet Ezekiel declares the voice of God as saying, "I will seek that which was lost, and bring again that which was driven away, and will bind up that which was broken, and will strengthen that which was sick" (34:16).

Correlative passages in the text of the sermon read from "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures" by Mary Baker Eddy declare, "All nature teaches God's love to man, but man cannot love God, supremely and set his whole affections on spiritual things, while loving the material or trusting in it more than in the spiritual." "Love giveth to the least spiritual idea might, immortality, and goodness, which shine through all as the blossom shines through all the bud." (pp. 328, 518).

**Pastors Consider Roles Of Minister, Psychiatrist**

"The Minister and the Psychiatrist" was the title of an address by Dr. Leon Wallace, M.D., psychiatrist, which was presented at the first annual Ministers' Seminar, of the Workshop of Creative Living, Inc.

Dr. Joseph Knowles, Th.D., director of the Baptist Counseling and Psychology - Tools for Creative Living.

Ministers and religious counselors of mixed denominations in the South Bay area attended the seminar, held recently at the Workshop, 24242 Hawthorne Avenue, in Waltham.

Dr. Wallace stressed the need for understanding, on the part of the ministry, of the patient's need for acceptance, and told of the psychologist's and minister's roles, and their aims for their counseling.

Dr. Knowles spoke of the compatibility of the religious and psychological viewpoints, and discussed the attitudes of the ministers in the counseling relationship. He also discussed the relationship of the minister to the individuals he helps. Acceptance of the person, no matter how troubled, was emphasized.

Among those attending the seminar were Rev. Lyle B. Gansel, Lutheran Church of the Resurrection; Rev. Harold E. Carlson, North Redondo Methodist Church; Rev. Lertis R. Ellett, Lawndale Church of Christ; Rev. Earl D. Barnum, Church of Religious Science, Redondo; and Rabbi Joel DeKoven, Hawthorne.

Director of the Workshop Mrs. Dorothy Law gave an opening discussion "The Challenges of Pastoral Counseling." Weekly classes in human relations, and family life education are offered to adults and the workshop also operates a state licensed nursery school program, according to Mrs. Lora Lytle, public relations chairman.
