

Veteran Aircraft Employee Full of Worthwhile Ideas

Sam Messineo is a craftsman with ideas—ideas which pay off. Messineo, a canopies and phenolics leadman at North American Aviation's Torrance plant, has been presented 12 cash awards during the past five months for acceptable ideas submitted in North American's monthly suggestion award program. Problem Studied. When North American received a U. S. Air Force contract to produce two-place F-100F Super Sabres—a fighter-bomber with supersonic speed—the company's Torrance plant was faced with the problem of enlarging the canopy used on other models of the Super Sabre from 101 to 133 inches. This is where Hawthorne resident Sam Messineo entered the suggestion award program. Sam came up with a solution

which enabled stretching of the plastic canopy, and then in 11 other suggestions over a five-month period submitted proposals in handling and forming the molded plastic, which produced increased efficiency. Messineo, who resides at 5308 W. 124th St., has been employed at North American Aviation's Los Angeles Division for over 14 years. Cecil Clarke, general foreman at the Torrance facility, points out that Messineo's suggestions have not only increased production capabilities, but have stimulated other canopy craftsmen into seeking more advanced methods in handling and forming the plastic material.
