## Douglas Man Honored for Twenty Years

Edwin W. Hamilton, 1665 W. 182nd St., Torrance, chief tool designer at the Torrance location, El Segundo division of the Douglas Aircraft Co., was honored on his 20th anniversary with Douglas when he was presented a diamond-studded anniversary pin by T. E. Springer, vice president-general manager of the El Segundo division.

Hamilton, 44, joined Douglas in 1936 as an aircraft assembler at the El Segundo division. He later transferred to the Santa Monica division and in 1940 returned to the El Segundo division as a senior leadman in the master layout department.

From 1941 to 1952 he held increasingly important positions in tooling, starting as an assistant supervisor, then foreman and general foreman, to assist a superintendent of tooling.

When the Torrance location was activated he was appointed chief tool designer. In that capacity, he is responsible for all planning, tool design and tool fabrication.

Hamilton and his wife, the former Nellie Reed, have two sons, Robert, 19, and Steven, 16. He commutes weekly to the family home, an avocado ranch, at Fallbrook, Calif.

## Summer Swim Program On At El Camino

Six hours of Saturday recreational swimming are currently being offered in the pools of El Camino College, with the public invited to use the modern facilities.

"Everyone 50 inches tall or taller may use the pools during the Saturday swimming hours," Merl F. Sloan, director of student personnel, announced yesterday adding that admission for adults is 25 cents. Children's tickets are 10 cents. Swimmers must furnish their own suits and towels.

One hour swimming periods begin at 8, 9, 10, and 11 a.m. and at 1 and 2 p.m. Tickets go on sale 15 minutes prior to the beginning of each swimming period.

"Family and organizational groups will find the 8 and 9 a.m. hours suitable for their needs, the pools being relatively uncrowded during these Saturday morning periods," Sloan said.

The pools are also open for recreational swimming nightly from 4 to 5 p.m. for all 50 inches tall, and over from 9 to 10 p.m. for adults 18 years of age and older. A family swimming hour is scheduled nightly from 7 to 8 p.m. Registration is unnecessary for swimming at any of these hours.
