## Drastic Action Asked to Curb Litterbugging

Drastic action in the campaign to end littering of public highways has been proposed to the Board of Supervisors by Supervisor Burton W. Chace.

Chace's proposal unanimously approved by the Board of Supervisors calls for the paying of a reward to anyone giving information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person unlawfully dumping any type of rubbish on public or private highways or roads or any public property.

He pointed out to his colleagues on the board that the new law which authorizes the reward has been passed by the Legislature and enacted into law by the Governor on July 2. The illegal dumping is already a misdemeanor, Chace stated.

"In every part of the County," the supervisor said, "this littering of public roads and parks is becoming a serious menace and it can only be corrected by severe and drastic action."

Chace said the problem is almost out of hand, particularly in the Compton area; but he declared that complaints also are pouring in from almost every section of the county.

Following approval of Chace's motion, the Board of Supervisors instructed the County Counsel to immediately study the problem and bring back recommendations as to the proper reward and also to confer with the County Road Department and the Sheriff's Office regarding the posting of signs along highways and roads in the unincorporated area, calling attention to the new provisions of the law.

No exact figure for the reward was set by the Board of Supervisors, but Chace in the discussion stated that he felt that \$50 would be a workable figure.
