## Mexico Earthquake Causes Awareness of Local Threat

The recent earthquake in Mexico City, along with reports of noted seismologists has caused an added awareness of earthquake threat in Southern California.

Dr. Charles F. Richter, Professor of Seismology at California Institute of Technology, in a report dated April 23, 1957, stated that everyone in California has to learn to live with the threat of a great earthquake and that a "rolled-up sleeves" attitude is in order.

Minor earthquakes, along with those of damaging intensity, are occurring frequently. Many of them are centered either in the ocean or in unpopulated areas, and therefore no damage results. However, recent quakes in the Far East, and the very recent one in Mexico City points up that another "great" earthquake could happen any time. Dr. Richter's report brings out that it has been a full century since Southern California has had a full-scale "great" earthquake, but that there is evidence that the strains in the earth have now accumulated to the point where the next great shock is not far off.

The San Andreas Fault cuts across Los Angeles County approximately 30 miles from Los Angeles City in the Antelope Valley area, and earthquakes are considered to be destructive for a distance of 25 to 30 miles on either side of the fault. The fault plane may be at an angle from the actual focus point which might be 10 miles below the surface of the ground. Therefore, the break through the earth crust may be some distance from the point where the shock is greatest on the surface.

Panic is one of the major concerns of Civil Defense officials in connection with earthquakes. However, there are certain simple rules that may be followed:

1. In a metropolitan area of multi-story buildings, do NOT run outside. Most earthquake injuries are caused by falling objects. Stand in an inside doorway, away from danger of flying glass, where heavy

beams will protect from falling plaster or collapsing walls. Or, seek shelter under a heavy table or other object that will support debris.

2. In a residential area, generally stay inside. However, if the shock is of a duration and intensity to threaten collapse of the structure, go into the yard. Be careful to stay in an area where falling chimneys, balconies, or other objects will not reach you.

3. Keep calm. Panic accounts for a large majority of injuries in any disaster.

4. Do not use matches or open flame until certain gas is not escaping. Remember that in any major disaster, Civil Defense will be on the job. Do your part now to prepare to meet disaster. Civil Defense will do its part in help-you overcome the results of disaster.
