## Like the Greeks, the Air Force Has a Name for It—Specialist

Wire Maintenance Specialist — you might think that's a glorified telephone lineman. Not in the U. S. Air Force. "While the Air Force's main job is flying," said Sergeant Leland "Lee" Mason, Air Force Recruiter for the Torrance area, "the rapid transfer of a large amount of information over long distances—in other words, communications—is essential to the effective operation of those aircraft. And specialists in the wire maintenance career field who keep the telephone and telegraph-type of communication open actually do much more than repair telephone lines." Air Force men and women in this career field repair telephones, teletypewriters, carrier-repeater and cryptographic (de-coding) devices, and install and maintain telephone and telegraph land-line systems. They keep these, and other similar types of equipment, in a constant state of

readiness, to be used at a moment notice. "These personnel," explained Sergeant Mason, "are trained in jobs similar to those of cable splicer, central office repairman, telephone inspector, teletype repairman, and senior lineman in civilian life. The techniques they learn are basically the same." However, qualified veterans who are already skilled in the proper military specialty may re-enlist directly for an assignment in their old type of job at a particular Air Force base or overseas area. Re-training into a more needed type of Air Force occupation is also open to qualified former servicemen who have experience in a "surplus" type of military job specialty. ## Cal-Vet Interest Rates Boosted to 3 1/2 Per Cent

All war veterans buying farms or homes with "Cal-Vet" loans—including those now under contract—will pay 3 1/2 per cent interest beginning Dec. 1st, an increase over the 3 per cent rate in effect the past 11 years. State Director of Veterans Affairs J. Maryn Russell announced that notices to all contract holders have gone in the mail, and the rate increase has been confirmed by the final authority, the Veterans Finance Committee, consisting of Gov. Goodwin J. Knight and several top state officials. The committee also authorized another sale of \$50,000,000 worth of veterans' bonds on Oct. 23rd. Russell pointed out that the low Cal-Vet loan rate has only been possible due to the flexibility permitted under the law, making possible periodic adjustments to the rise and fall of the money market.

"This is the first time an upward adjustment of interest has been necessary," he said. "During the first 23 years of the Cal-Vet program World War I veterans paid 5 per cent interest for these loans as a matter of course. The rate dropped to 4 per cent in 1945 and to 3 per cent in 1948. "Since the interest rate is determined by the sale of bonds in a free economy, Cal-Vet loans are bound to reflect fluctuations in the cost of money. But eligible California veterans continue to enjoy a definite advantage over other forms of financing." Russell revealed that last week's eligibility certificates issued by the Department of Korea veterans reached 53,326, and at that point equalled and have since outdistanced—the number of World War I veterans on the rolls. Korea veterans are still establishing eligibility to participate in the program at the rate of some 1200 a month, while World War I veterans' applications have slowed down to around 30 a month.

## Bloodmobile Will Be Here On Oct. 3rd

The local branch of American Red Cross once again will stage a blood bank drive on Oct. 3 at the Civic Auditorium, according to Gordon S. Jones, blood recruitment chairman.

A goal of 250 donors is the aim of the day with processing beginning at 2 a.m. and continuing until 6:30 p.m.

As the population is increasing every month, it is hoped that many new prospective donors will telephone the local office for an appointment, FA 3-0510. Previous donors and all groups will be contacted within the next few weeks.

Mrs. Pat Orsini, new vice-chairman for blood recruitment, is at the local office Wednesday afternoons.

Latest regulation on donating is that a person has to wait two weeks following a polio shot before they can donate blood. Married minors under 21 years of age may donate without a release signed by their parents. Unmarried minors 18 to 21 years of age may obtain a release slip from the local office so their parents may sign it. Age limit is still 60 years of age.
