PROPOSED HOSPITAL . . . Preliminary plans and engineering for the proposed new 50-bed \$900,000 Bay Harbor Osteopathic Hospital will be rushed during the coming week by Architect Hugh Davies of Long Beach who has been retained by the Osteopathic group to design the facility. Here is a preliminary artistic conception of the facility, planned to be constructed in the Lomita-Harbor City area.

Architect Named for Proposed Bay-Harbor Osteopathic Hospital

Preparation of architectural drawings and engineering plans for a proposed \$900,000, 50-bed Bay Harbor Osteopathic Hospital were being rushed today following announcement that Hugh Davies, Long Beach architect has been retained to design the new facility.

Davies, designer of the Long Beach Osteopathic Hospital completed less than two years ago, was selected by a special architectural committee composed of Herbert Davis of San Pedro, chairman; R. E. Shonard of Palos Verdes Estates, Dr. Donald G. Cortum of Redondo Beach, Dr. Chesley R. Houske of Torrance and Dr. Donald M. Patterson of Lomita and Harbor City. His appointment was confirmed by the board of directors of the hospital.

Plans Presented
Preliminary engineering work and plans for the new Bay Harbor Osteopathic Hospital were presented to officials of the State Department of Public Health at a special meeting in Los Angeles yesterday.

Selection of a site for the proposed hospital is scheduled to follow soon, according to Glenn A. Wymore, president of the hospital board of directors. Tentative sites in the Lomita-Harbor City area are under consideration as the location is a central one for the Bay-Harbor area. Communities to be served include San Pedro, Wilmington, Harbor City, Lomita, Waveria, Rolling Hills, Palos Verdes Estates, Redondo Beach, Torrance, Hermosa Beach, Manhattan Beach and Gardena.

Selection of Glenn Moore, Redondo Beach insurance man, as a director of the Bay-Harbor Osteopathic Hospital was also announced by Wymore. Moore's appointment completes the 25-man board.


