

GATES OPEN TO TEST REVERSE PSYCHOLOGY

In addition to its "open door" policy, the Torrance schools are also going to have an "open gate" policy.

School officials have decided that the gates to the local institutions of learning will be left open at all times. In the past, the gates have been locked at night.

Reverse Psychology
The reason for the change is that the experiment of leaving gates open at all times uses a sort of reverse psychology. Several school districts which have tried the experiment have found that there is a measurable and noticeable reduction in vandalism as a result.

Apparently, the open gates make potential vandals feel that they are welcome guests

at the schools, and as such, are less inclined to be naughty. Many schools have been troubled in the past with broken windows, break-ins, and damage to the buildings and fixtures.

Protection Sought
According to School Superintendent J. H. Hull, the basic reason for fencing school property is not to prevent people from getting in, but to provide proper protection for children on the school grounds.

It may come as a surprise to some people to learn that philosophy has anything to do with the height of school fences, but it does. Fencing at schools has been reduced from eight to six feet, not because of money, but because of the "open gate" philosophy.

League Raps Incorporation Claims in Oct. 29 Election

"Special favors for a few. High taxation for you. Politicians furnish the rule. We furnish the homes. It's just their rule of our homes."

That's the cry of the Lomita Civic League as it battles the proposed incorporation of Lomita, which will come up for vote on Oct. 29.

Brochure Printed
In a brochure prepared for mass distribution, the League charges that taxes would go up and "Lomita as a city would be dead broke." The League claims that money would have to be borrowed to start running the city and that only a high city tax rate could get Lomita out of debt.

"Don't be fooled by figures jiggled by 'experts' who throw earmarked funds (that cannot be spent for government expenses) into an 'unappropriated surplus' to fake their claim that income would ex-

ceed costs, when the exact opposite is true," the brochure says. "Taxes would go up plenty. And for what? Less than we are getting now of everything but trouble."

Zoning Expires
County zoning would expire when Lomita incorporated, the League says, and there is no guarantee of future zoning which would be up to the city council.

The League also charges that incorporation would mean a number of "soft jobs" for friends of the city council.

"They try to make us believe that this 'home rule' is a lovely thing but upon examination it is seen to be nothing but sugar bait," the brochure says. "If we fall for it we would be just like the fish that's safely landed in the boat. We could flop all we would get fried just the same."



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
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
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WHAT'S DOING

When you hear air hissing out of an auto tire, first thing you do is find the leak and have it fixed. Same thing goes for some telephone cables. They've got compressed air in them.
