

Water Question To Get Public's Attention Again

Public attention locally will again be focused on the question of the state's water needs when the Joint Legislative Committee on Water Resources Development Problems meets here in Los Angeles on Nov. 19 and 20.

This will be the first meeting in Los Angeles of the 18-member group that was created especially to seek agreement between conflicting sectional viewpoints in advance of a special session of the Legislature to enact legislation activating a definite state water program.

Although previous hearings have been held in other parts of the state, it was my suggestion that the Los Angeles meeting be reserved until this time, when we are about ready for an all-out discussion of the scene where a future water supply is of the greatest possible concern.

Progress Claimed

During this interval I believe we have made real progress in drawing together insofar as our local position is concerned. This has been accomplished through a series of meetings with representatives of interested groups, all of which are better coordinated and more harmonious in their views than they were when the 1957 Legislature adjourned in early June.

During the forthcoming hearings the Los Angeles position will thus be clarified and set out in detail through spokesmen for the major water groups, who will include Joseph Jensen for the Metropolitan Water District, William S. Peterson for the Department of Water and Power, and William Rosencrans for the Los Angeles Chamber of Commerce.

New Proposals

Some new proposals will be made by Southern California jointly, and it is hoped they will find favor through a more receptive attitude on the part of Northern California representatives on the committee.

Since public support in all parts of the state is vitally necessary to the success of any water plan, local community leaders, working through the Chamber of Commerce, are making a valuable contribution in meeting with northern leaders to exchange ideas and iron out differences with a view to greater understanding on the part of the general public in all communities.

Insight Shown

In our local meetings preparatory to the forthcoming hearings by the water committee, Assemblymen Carley V. Porter, of Compton, and Harold Levering, of Santa Monica, have shown great insight into the essential problems, and great diligence in coordinating our own efforts towards an early agreement which will be satisfactory to the south and agreeable to northern interests which up to now have viewed any proposal from this area with varying degrees of mistrust.

We who have the task of negotiating an agreement on the legislative level are all grateful for the time and thought given by local businessmen and civic leaders in helping us to open up avenues of approach that we hope will lead to a solution of the problem once and for all.

Ladies Plan Sale of Food


