Boy Scouts, who last year collected 265,000 pounds of clothing in one day for charity, will be out again in full force on Saturday, Dec. 7. That date has been designated Good Turn Day, and 150,000 Scouts will try to top last year's record haul of used clothing and household articles.

Dinner Will Honor Knight On Birthday

over to four agencies: the Salvation Army, Goodwill Industries, Volunteers of America, and St. Vincent De Paul Society. During the winter months, thousands of handicapped people are kept busy renovating the clothing. If there were no Good Turn Day, most of these people would be unemployed.

Boy Scouts from five Councils are participating in the drive for clothing, including Los Angeles Area Council, San Fernando Valley Council, Verdugo Hills Council, Crescent Bay Council and San Gabriel Valley Council.

About two weeks before the drive, Scouts leave large paper bags with householders in their neighborhood, asking them to fill them with discarded clothing and articles. Then, on Dec. 7, every Scout is mobilized and picks up his Good Turn Bags on the same day. They are dropped at neighborhood collection points, and trucks from one of the four agencies pick up the bags. By midnight, the entire operation is completed.

The trucks stop at 600 collection points and travel about 6000 miles picking up Good Turn Bags filled with clothing.

Last year more than 92,000 children's garments were collected, in addition to such items as 40,000 pair of shoes and 2500 overcoats. But the real worth of the Good Turn Day comes with the knowledge that handicapped people are being gainfully employed renovating the material, and that children and adults will be warmly and adequately dressed during the winter.
